Description of daily work

Math

Individual and small group work that targets math facts and concepts appropriate to the grade and supports the needs of the student. The math question of the day includes practice with word problems and survey questions.

Reading

Independent reading, small group work, and individual meetings between each student and the teacher to target reading strategies and skills focusing on building reading habits.

Read Aloud

Teachers read to the children and model comprehension strategies. The students will also participate in book discussions based on the read aloud.

Writing Conferences

Individual and small group work that targets writing strategies and skills that focus on building grade level writing habits.

GLAD Units

Thematic units that target literacy and language skills

Meals

Attendance

Your commitment to this program is crucial. Your child should not miss more than 2 days of summer school.

Consistent attendance and appropriate behavior are necessary for the success of this program. Any difficulties in these areas may result in a conference to decide if your child will continue with the program.

Summer School Program Dress Code

We ask that students attending the summer program dress in comfortable summer clothes including long and short-sleeved T-shirts and long pants or shorts.

All shoes should be flat and have a closed toe. Pants, shorts and shirts should fit appropriately so that the mid-section of the body is completely covered, and they can play comfortably on the playground equipment.
